SUMMARY:

The League of California Cities Conference is scheduled for September 5 -7, 2012. We are fortunate to be able to send three Council Members including the Mayor as well as key staff members to this annual event which will be held in San Diego. As you know, the League of California Cities is a vital forum for the Town Council and staff to gain valuable information regarding local government operations as well as participate in the legislative process as we work toward making stronger cities and a better California.
