## The High Desert Corridor (HDC) is moving along.

The project proposes to link SR-14 in Los Angeles County with SR-18 in San Bernardino County. This connection would link some of the fastest growing residential, commercial, and industrial growth areas in Southern California, including the cities of Palmdale, Lancaster, Adelanto, Victorville and the Town of Apple Valley.

The Draft Environmental Impact Statement/ Environmental Impact Report is expected to be available for public review late 2013.
