RECOMMENDED ACTION:

That the Town Council:

- 1. Accept the work completed as part of the Central Road Overlay Project Bear Valley Road to Poppy Road for a total cost of \$236,132.10.
- 2. Direct the Town Clerk to file the Notice of Completion for the contract work.
- 3. Direct the Finance Director to release retained funds 30 days after the Notice of Completion has been filed, provided no claims are filed against the contractor.

SUMMARY:

On August 28, 2012, the Town awarded a contract to Sully-Miller Contracting Co. for the Central Road Overlay Project – Bear Valley Road to Poppy Road. The contract was to provide necessary labor, equipment, and materials for the installation of asphalt pavement overlay on Central Road from Bear Valley Road to Poppy Road and included necessary grading and striping.

Sully-Miller Contracting Co. satisfactorily completed the work under this contract on November 13, 2012. The total contract cost is \$236,132.10.

BACKGROUND:

The Town has jurisdiction over the full-width of Central Road between Bear Valley Road and Las Tunas Road (0.5-miles), and the Town and County share jurisdiction of equal half-widths from Las Tunas Road to Poppy Road (1.5-miles). The jurisdictional share of this project is 60% to the Town and 40% to the County.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this project has been appropriated in the Town Council approved 2012-2013 Capital Improvement Projects Budget. Under the Cooperative Agreement with the County of San Bernardino approved on June 12, 2012 the Town will pay the contractor for the total contract cost and the County will reimburse the Town \$94,452.84 (40% of the total contract cost).
