RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. That the Town Council reviews and approves the project plans, specifications, and bid documents for the construction of the Apple Valley Road and Town Center Drive Improvements project.
2. That the Town Council authorizes staff to solicit bids for construction of said project.

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for the Apple Valley Road and Town Center Drive Improvements have been prepared and approved by staff. Staff has reviewed the plans for this project and is satisfied that the specifications meet the intent of the Town Council for this project. The project plans and specifications are available to the Town Council for review, approval, and authorization to proceed with advertisement of this project. Staff recommends that the Town Council review the plans and specifications that are available in the Town Council Office; approve the documents, and direct staff to proceed with advertising for construction of the project.

BACKGROUND:

The Apple Valley Road and Town Center Drive Improvements are intended to improve the flow of traffic through this area of Apple Valley Road. The construction will remove the existing raised median and construct a new raised median approximately 11 feet to the west of the current location. This will provide the northbound lanes with an

additional 11 feet of roadway width as well as increase the storage capacity of the northbound left turn lane. Upon completion of the median relocation, the roadway will be restriped to improve the flow of traffic and to provide for the addition of a northbound Class II bike lane through the area. The intersection of Apple Valley Road and Town Center Drive will also be restriped to align with the new lane configuration and bike lane signs will be installed to bring the existing southbound bike lane up to current standards.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this project has been appropriated in the Town Council approved 2012-2013 Capital Improvement Projects Budget. There is no immediate fiscal impact with approval of the bid documents and authorization to advertise for bids.
