RECOMMENDED ACTION:

- 1. That the Town Council review and approve the project plans, specifications, and bid documents for the Bear Valley Road and Mohawk Road Traffic Signal -Project No. 2012-07.
- 2. That the Town Council authorize staff to solicit bids for construction of said project.

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for the Bear Valley Road and Mohawk Road Traffic Signal -Project No. 2012-07 have been prepared and are ready for approval and advertisement of bids. Staff has reviewed the plans and specifications and is satisfied that they meet the intent of the Town Council for this project. The project plans and specifications are available to the Town Council for review, approval, and authorization to proceed with advertisement of the project. Staff recommends that the Town Council review the plans and specifications that are available in the Town Council office, approve the documents, and direct staff to proceed with advertising for construction of the project.

BACKGROUND:

This Highway Safety Improvement Program (HISP) grant funded project includes the construction of a new traffic signal, associated striping, pedestrian access ramps, and a dry-well at the intersection of Bear Valley Road and Mohawk/Mulitnomah Road. The project will construct improvements to the existing pedestrian access ramp and construction of new access ramps and crosswalks to facilitate pedestrians crossing at

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
the intersection. The project will also include the installation of a dry-well to alleviate flooding conditions.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this project has been appropriated in the Town Council approved 2014-2015 Capital Improvement Projects Budget. There is no immediate fiscal impact with approval of the bid documents and authorization to advertise for bids.
