BACKGROUND:

This project includes the construction of a new traffic signal, associated striping, pedestrian access ramps, and a dry-well at the intersection of Bear Valley Road and Mohawk/Multnomah Road. The project will improve the existing pedestrian access ramp, and construct new access ramps and crosswalks. The project will also include the installation of a dry-well to help minimize flooding conditions.

The bid documents for the project were reviewed by Staff for accuracy and constructability. The bid documents and the authorization to advertise were approved by Town Council on September 23, 2014. The bid opening was held on November 25, 2014.

FISCAL IMPACT:


There is currently \$404,161.00 available and budgeted in the Transportation Impact Fee fund for this project. The projected cost for construction is \$346,788.50 of which \$243,000.00 will be reimbursed through a Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant.
