While supplies last

Everything you need to do with your crew:

- Keep 'em safe and sound. Distribute water as needed and watch for anything potentially dangerous that • shouldn't be handled.
- If you come across any hazardous materials, please note the location and report it to Julie. •
- Report any illness or injury to Julie. •
- Need more trash bags? Code Enforcement and Public Work helpers have more supplies. Ask them if you see them drive by. If not, call Julie.
- If you finished your site and still have supplies, you may go to another site on the map you were given. •
- Have a reporter wanting some information? Call Julie (760) 403-5437. •
- Have a resident walk up who wants to help? Have them come to Town Hall or call Julie. •
- Got pictures?! Turn in any photos taken during your clean up. You can email them to jgilmer@applevalley.org or drop off pictures to Town Hall.
- Supplies are limited. So, if you have your own trash bag ties, gloves, trash grabbers, water, etc. we encourage you to bring them.

When you are finished with your lot COUNT YOUR TRASH BAGS, write the number on your return supply sheet and take note of any large or unusual items. Place all filled bags along the side of the road all in one location. MAKE SURE BAGS ARE TIED.

It is very important that you count your bags! Don't forget! Call and tell us how many. For Adopt A Street participants, please also let us know where your bags are.

All Done?

Bring your team back to Town Hall for lunch at the recreation center at noon (no earlier please). At this time you will **return your supplies**. Pat yourself on the back for assisting in "Community Clean Up Day!"
