Eligibility Criteria

1) A member of a “Veteran Family”

- A veteran or a member of a family in which the head of household or the spouse is a veteran
- Veteran must have a discharge status other than dishonorable

AND BE

2) Very low or extremely low income

- household income must not exceed 50% of area median income

AND

3) Occupying Permanent Housing (PH)

- Residing in PH or;
- Are homeless and schedule to enter PH within 90-days or;
- Have exited PH within the previous 90 days

AND

4) Be able to sustain housing after temporary financial assistance ends



S.S.V.F. Program

The goal of the S.S.V.F. Program is to promote housing stability among very low-income veteran families who reside in or are transitioning to permanent housing

Required Documentation

- ID and Social Security Cards
- DD-214 Form
- Lease/homeless verification
- Eviction Notice
- Income verification
- Bank Statements

Services Available

- Outreach Services
- Case Management
- Legal Services
- Community Links/Referrals

Temporary Financial Assistance

- Rental Arrears
- Rental payment Assistance
- Deposits (security or utility)
