

- Withdrawal After Class Start Date: A refund may be requested by completing a "Refund Request" form prior to the second class meeting and is subject to the approval of the Recreation Department Manager. A pro-ration of the class fee will be charged.
- NO refund requests will be accepted after the second class meeting.
- A \$2 processing fee will be charged to all refunds.
- Allow 4-6 weeks for a refund check.
- NO refunds for swim lessons or aquatic classes.
