RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. That the Town Council review and approve the project plans, specifications, and bid documents for the Powhatan Road Street Improvement – Project No. 2015-03.
2. That the Town Council authorize staff to solicit bids for construction of said project.

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for the Powhatan Road Street Improvement – Project No. 2015-03 have been prepared and are ready for approval and advertisement of bids. Staff has reviewed the plans and specifications and is satisfied that they meet the intent of the Town Council for this project. The project plans and specifications are available to the Town Council for review, approval, and authorization to proceed with advertisement of the project. Staff recommends that the Town Council review the plans and specifications that are available in the Town Council Office, approve the documents, and direct staff to proceed with advertising for construction of the project.

BACKGROUND:

This project constructs curb, gutters and sidewalks, A.D.A. access ramps, commercial driveway approaches, a standard bus turnout and restripes the existing street on Powhattan Road from Navajo Road east along the north boundary of the Town's Community Park, and along the north side of Powhattan Road from Navajo Road, east, adjacent to the Town owned parking lot.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this project has been appropriated in the Town Council approved 2014-2015 Capital Improvement Projects Budget. There is no immediate fiscal impact with approval of the bid documents and authorization to advertise for bids.
