#### SUMMARY:

In June of 2012, a 33% increase in our summer lap swim fee was adopted and at the same time, a "Winter Surcharge" was established, bringing the base Lap Swim fees to \$4 (May – September) and \$5 (October – April).

After discussions with our current and former patrons and a look at participation numbers, it has become apparent that our fees are affecting the participation level for our lap swim program.

Since the increase has been implemented, there has been an adverse affect on participation levels:

2011-12 – 5737 patrons participated in lap swim programming

2013-14 – 4611 patrons participated in lap swim programming

Staff believes a reduction in the lap swim fee of \$1 in each the winter and the summer will increase participation numbers and provide a much needed service for our community. The Apple Valley Aquatic Center is currently the only public facility in the High Desert in which residents can enjoy Lap Swimming; the closest alternative is the

Fontana Park Aquatic Center, which is currently charging adults \$3 for a daily drop-in pass. Additionally, our daily public swim fee is \$3 for adults.

In reducing these fees, we believe that we will return to our previous levels of participation; allowing us to serve more residents, while maintaining our cost recovery.

The summer season would have a base price of \$3, and the winter season \$4. The winter fee will continue to include the winter surcharge due to the increased costs associated with operating our Aquatic Center in the colder months.

Adoption of the proposed fee change would affect our Multi-use passes as follows:
