RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. That the Town Council review and approve the project plans, specifications, and bid documents for the Ramona Road Widening and Rancho Verde Elementary School Safe Routes to School– Project No. 2014-04.
2. That the Town Council authorize staff to solicit bids for construction of said project.

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for the Ramona Road Widening and Rancho Verde Elementary School Safe Routes to School – Project No. 2014-04 have been prepared and are ready for approval and advertisement of bids. Staff has reviewed the plans and specifications and is satisfied that they meet the intent of the Town Council for this project. The project plans and specifications are available to the Town Council for review, approval, and authorization to proceed with advertisement of the project. Staff recommends that the Town Council review the plans and specifications that are available in the Town Council Office, approve the documents, and direct staff to proceed with advertising for construction of the project.

BACKGROUND:

This project will widen Ramona Road to a total asphalt width of 36 feet from Navajo Road to Central Road. Upon completion, Ramona Road will include the addition of two (2) bike lanes. All of the widening takes place within the existing right-of-way. This project also includes the construction of a new concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter along

both sides of Pioneer Road between Ramona Road and the school's southerly property line, four (4) commercial driveway approaches on the school property, six (6) residential driveway approaches, four (4) ADA access ramps and updating all existing school signs to current code specifications.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this project has been appropriated in the Town Council approved 2014-2015 Capital Improvement Projects Budget. There is no immediate fiscal impact with approval of the bid documents and authorization to advertise for bids.
