The Position

Under general supervision, will perform a wide variety of duties relative to assisting with the operation of recreational activities and programs for the Town, as well as working at the pool. In addition, may provide general office duties using computer skills. This particular position will have varying schedules with potential hours from 8 am until 10 pm, Monday through Sunday, and may include up to 40 hours per week during the summer months.

Job Functions

- Perform program registration and cashiering duties
- Develop, coordinate and implement youth activities at an assigned facility.
- Supervise youth in a variety of activities.
- Handle medical emergencies and render first aid as required.
- Provide basic supervision, training and coaching to assigned staff.
- Other duties as assigned and as outlined on the job description.

Qualifications

Equivalent to completion of twelfth (12th) grade and one (1) year of experience performing cashier and related duties. Must possess the ability to communicate effectively with children, parents, and Town of Apple Valley staff. Must be 16 years of age or older; incumbents under the age of 18, who are required to attend school must provide a California Worker's Permit. . CPR and 1st Aid required. Prospective employees would be required to register for certification within one week of the offer.

License: Valid California class C driver's license with satisfactory driving record and automobile insurance.
