RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. That the Town Council review and approve the project plans, specifications and bid documents for the Yucca Loma Elementary School Safe Routes to School – Project No. 2016-01.
2. That the Town Council authorize staff to solicit bids for construction of said project.

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for the Yucca Loma Elementary School - Safe Routes to School, Project No. 2016-01 have been prepared and are ready for approval and advertisement of bids. Staff has reviewed the plans and specifications and is satisfied that they meet the intent of the Town Council for this project. The project plans and specifications are available to the Town Council for review, approval and authorization to proceed with advertisement of the project. Staff recommends that the Town Council review the plans and specifications that are available in the Town Council Office, approve the documents and direct staff to proceed with advertising for construction of the project, contingent on Caltrans' approval to proceed with construction.

BACKGROUND:

The Town of Apple Valley was awarded a grant from the Safe Routes To School Program for street improvements along the entire frontage of Yucca Loma Elementary School. The pavement will be widened and new sidewalk, curb, gutter, ADA access ramps and commercial driveways will be constructed along Yucca Loma Road between Mohawk Road and Rancherias Road and along Rancherias Road between Yucca Loma Road and Powhatan Road.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no immediate fiscal impact with approval of the bid documents and authorization to advertise for bids.
