Thank you for choosing Apple Valley for your place to do business. The Town of Apple Valley welcomes your business and will strive to make the process of doing business within the Town as simple as possible. This information sheet is designed to assist you in successfully opening your business in the Town, as well as provide you with federal, state, and county regulations and requirements.

The requirement of possessing a business license has existed within the Town since 1991. Your business tax payment is valid for one year from the day your business commences in Apple Valley and expires on the last day of the month from the year of issuance. Please be aware that you will be assessed a monthly penalty for late payment of your license. Penalties are assessed on the last day of each month after payment is due.

Planning Review. Individuals interested in starting a business within the Town of Apple Valley are strongly encouraged to take a moment and stop by the Planning Division counter and discuss their business/activity with a member of the Planning Division. If your business is going to be home based, you will be required to obtain a Home Occupancy Permit. Or if you are going to be located in a commercial area you may need to apply for a Conditional or Special Use Permit. You may contact anyone in the Planning Division at (760) 240-7000, extension 7200.
Certificate of Occupancy. All businesses located in commercial areas of Apple Valley are required to fill out a Certificate of Occupancy application. If any tenant improvements are being done to the building, additional fees may be required. For more information, please contact the Building and Safety Department at (760) 240-7000, extension 7014.
Retailers. Please provide proof that you have obtained a Sellers Permit from the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration. The Sellers Permit must match the business information on your application for a business license. You can contact the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration by calling or going on line (see reverse side for contact information.)
Fictitious Business Name Statement. Please provide proof of publication for a Fictitious Business Name Statement. To find out if you are required to file, please contact the San Bernardino County Recorder's or any local newspaper and speak with the legal advertising department (see reverse side for contact information.)
State Licenses. Many businesses are required to be licensed with California Department of Consumer Affairs. Proof of all state licenses is required in order to obtain a business license with the Town of Apple Valley. Please call Consumer Affairs to see what licenses, if any, are required (see reverse side for contact information.)
