Subject: FEE WAIVER REQUEST FOR THE SALVATION ARMY THANKSGIVING DAY DINNER NOVEMBER 24, 2016 AT THE JAMES WOODY COMMUNITY CENTER

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

For good cause shown, and finding a waiver will serve a public purpose, approve the waiver of the Facility Rental Fee of \$91.53.

SUMMARY:

The Salvation Army of Victor Valley is requesting use of the Auditorium at the James Woody Community Center on November 24, 2016, in order to provide a free Thanksgiving meal for those in the community. They anticipate serving 100 – 150 meals to people who would otherwise have nowhere else to go for Thanksgiving dinner. The fees come to \$91.53. The organization will still be required to provide a Certificate of Insurance.

BACKGROUND:

On August 14, 2001, the Town Council adopted a policy stating fees can be administratively waived for a local public agency, a utility company or service district, or a similar entity providing an essential service to the general community, whereas, non-profit requests for fee waivers must go before the Town Council for consideration.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Although there is not an ongoing demand that is displaced with the request on this particular day, the waiving of these fees will result in the loss of potential revenue in the amount of \$91.53.
