RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. That the Town Council review and approve the project plans, specifications, and bid documents for the Navajo Road Rehabilitation - Project No. 2015-01.
2. That the Town Council authorize staff to solicit bids for construction of said project.

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for the Navajo Road Rehabilitation -- Project No. 2015-01 have been prepared and are ready for approval and advertisement for bids. Staff has reviewed the plans and specifications and is satisfied that they meet the intent of the Town Council for this project. The project plans and specifications are available for the Town Council to review, approval, and authorize to proceed with advertisement of the project. Staff recommends that the Town Council review the plans and specifications that are available in the Town Council Office, approve the documents, and direct staff to proceed with advertising for construction.

BACKGROUND:

The project includes rehabilitating Navajo Road from Highway 18 at the north and Bear Valley Road at the south. The project will include grinding and repaving damaged portions of road, cape sealing, and adding new striping. In addition, a new catch basin will be installed north of Ottawa Road to alleviate flooding. Lastly, the handicap ramps will be fitted with surface-mounted truncated domes bringing them into current ADA compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this project has been appropriated in the Town Council approved 2017-2018 Capital Improvement Project Budget. There is no immediate fiscal impact with approval of the bid documents and authorization to advertise for bids.
