Discussion on Implementation of Non-Resident Fee Structure for Facility Rentals and Recreation Programming

SUMMARY STATEMENT

A recommendation to pursue the implementation of a non-resident fee structure was discussed and recommended by the Park and Recreation Commission at the May 1, 2008, Park and Recreation Commission Meeting. Listed below is a list of potential non-resident fees and discussion topics.

Potential Non-Resident Fees

It would be difficult to implement non-resident fees for **one-day events** where registration and collection of fees is done on site. Examples – Kiddie Carnival charges a ticket fee, Haunted House has a fee collected on site

Youth Sports and Recreation Programs - \$2.00 per program or session

Facilities Rental Fees – Could implement a per hour non-resident fee or a one-time per event flat non-resident fee.

Runs - We currently charge a pre-registration fee of \$13 and an on-site fee of \$15. Rather than implement a non-resident fee that has to be dealt with in the field, perhaps only allow pre-registration for Apple Valley residents.

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Aquatic Center – Attempting to implement a non-resident fee for lap swimmers or walk-in customers and the verification process on-site would be problematic. Perhaps look to implement a resident and non-resident membership pass fee. This would be a one-time fee and we currently have to check residency and verify for the waivers. Current membership fee is \$2.00 per person. Perhaps have a non-resident membership pass fee of \$5.00.

Contract Classes – Could add an additional non-resident fee to the monthly registration fee – perhaps \$2.00. Another possibility would be to look into classes that reach their capacity and only implement fees for those.
