TOWN MANAGER'S COMMENTS & LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Frank Robinson, Town Manager, addressed statements made in the Apple Valley Review regarding the Town's Emergency Preparedness Program. He stated that the Town has a very active Emergency Preparedness Program, which has been transitioned in-house. He recognized Mr. Joseph Ramos, Emergency Preparedness Coordinator, for his work on the program. He was pleased to announce that the Town of Apple Valley's Cert program is also very healthy. He thanked Ms. Dawn Harrison who recently joined the Town as Volunteer Coordinator to manage the program and bring Cert Training to all of the employees at Town Hall. He noted that throughout this transition, the Town has been working closely with the Apple Valley Fire Protection District, as well as, the school district in an effort to elevate the emergency preparedness within the school and fire district boundaries.

Mr. Robinson commented on various grants that the Town is working on that will enhance the quality of life in not only the Town of Apple Valley but the high desert region. He announced that on Thursday, March 12, 2015, beginning at 6:00 a.m. through 8:00 p.m., there is scheduled to be approximately seven thousand tons of concrete that will be poured into the frame on the Yucca Loma Bridge. He invited the Council Members to attend the event once confirmation of the event has been scheduled.
