RECOMMENDED ACTION:

- A. That the Town Council review and approve the bid documents for Bear Valley Road Bus Stop Improvements Project No. 2018-05.
- B. That the Town Council authorize staff to solicit bids for construction of said project.

SUMMARY:

Bid documents for the Bear Valley Road Bus Stop Improvement No. 2018-05 have been prepared and are ready for approval and advertisement of bids. Staff has reviewed the documents and is satisfied that they meet the intent of the Town Council for this project. The documents are available to the Town Council for review, approval, and authorization to proceed with advertisement of the project. Staff recommends that the Town Council review bid documents that are available in the Town Council Office, approve the documents, and direct staff to proceed with advertising for construction of the project.

BACKGROUND:

The project will construct a new a new VVTA standard bus turnout on Bear Valley Road between the easterly intersection of Outer Bear Valley Road and Snapping Turtle Road where a bus shelter currently exists. In addition, 10' wide sidewalk and ADA ramps will be constructed closing the gap between the existing sidewalk to the east of the bus shelter and to the west of Snapping Turtle.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this project has been appropriated in the Town Council approved 2018-2019 Capital Improvement Projects Budget using Local Transportation Funds. There is no immediate fiscal impact with approval of the bid documents and authorization to advertise for bids.
