RECOMMENDED ACTION:

- A. That the Town Council review and approve the bid documents for the Hitt Road Drainage Improvement – Project No. 2018-08

- B. That the Town Council authorize staff to solicit bids for construction of said project.

SUMMARY:

Bid documents for the Hitt Road Drainage Improvement Project No. 2018-08 have been prepared and are ready for approval and advertisement of bids. Staff has reviewed the documents and is satisfied that they meet the intent of the Town Council for this project. The documents are available to the Town Council for review, approval, and authorization to proceed with advertisement of the project. Staff recommends that the Town Council approve the documents, and direct staff to proceed with advertising for construction of the project.

BACKGROUND:

The Project consists of providing necessary labor, equipment and materials to correct drainage issues at the intersection of Hitt Road and Outer Highway 18 South to include removal and replacement of the existing trench drain, removal and replacement of curb, placement of 8" Portland Cement Concrete, and all other tasks as specified in the plans and technical specifications, and as directed by the Town Engineer. The existing trench drain at the intersection was constructed shortly after the Town's incorporation to improve

drainage. Since that time, the trench drain structure has deteriorated and requires frequent maintenance. A more permanent solution has been designed and will be constructed with this project.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this drainage improvement project is available in our Drainage Impact Fee Fund, and has been appropriated in the Town Council approved 2018-2019 Capital Improvement Projects Budget. There is no immediate fiscal impact with approval of the bid documents and authorization to advertise for bids.
