8. Resolution 2019-02, to Record Delinquent Utility Fees and Costs Against Real Property Located in the Town of Apple Valley and Directing that Said Assessments Constitute a Lien Upon Said Properties

Mayor Cusack opened the public hearing at 7:03 p.m.

Sydnie Harris, Director of Finance, presented the staff report as filed with the Town Clerk.

Council Member Leon expressed concern regarding the amount of time that it takes to place a lien on property. She recommended that a process be implemented that would expedite the placement of a lien instead of delaying the process six months which can result in individuals that did not cause the lien, incurring the cost.

Cecil Volsch, Real Estate Broker, stated that he did not agree with liens being placed on the tax roll. He spoke on the issues that happen in the real estate industry when bills are placed on the tax roll and new property owners incur the debt.

There being no requests to speak, Mayor Cusack closed the public hearing at 7:11 p.m.

Discussion ensued regarding reviewing options to alleviate the concerns expressed by the Town Council.

Anthony Thomas, Apple Valley, stated that he did not receive a notice on the proposed annexation. He believed that he resided in the area that should have been notified.

Doug Robertson, Apple Valley, explained that Mr. Thomas' property was not included in the annexation and therefore would not be included in the mailing. He also noted that LAFCO mails the notices, but the Town of Apple Valley pays for the notices to be mailed.

C. Direct staff to agendize for Town Council consideration the Resolution for filing and plan for service and a Resolution for environmental clearance for said annexation within one year.
