RECOMMENDED ACTION

Award a contract to PK Construction for the Hitt Road Drainage Improvement Project No. 2018-08 subject to “Approval as to Form” by the Town Attorney and “Approval as to Content” by the Town Manager.

BACKGROUND

The existing trench drain at the intersection was constructed shortly after the Town’s incorporation to improve drainage. Since that time, the trench drain structure has deteriorated and requires frequent maintenance. A more permanent solution has been designed and will be constructed with this project.

ANALYSIS

On April 16, 2019, the Town received and opened bids for the subject project. The Project consists of providing necessary labor, equipment and materials to correct drainage issues at the intersection of Hitt Road and Outer Highway 18 South to include removal and replacement of the existing trench drain, removal and replacement of curb, placement of 8” Portland Cement Concrete, and all other tasks as specified in the plans and technical specifications, and as directed by the Town Engineer.

The bid results are as follows:

<u>Contractor</u>	<u>Base Bid Price</u>
1. PK Construction	\$37,500.00
2. TSR Construction and Inspection	\$87,742.00
3. GM Sager Construction Company	\$112,960.00
4. TK Construction	\$174,710.00

Upon review of the submitted bid package and contacting PK Construction's references Engineering staff deemed them a responsive responsible bidder and recommends award.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for this project has been appropriated in the Town Council approved 2018-2019 Capital Improvement Projects Budget using Drainage Impact Fees.
