FOUR-WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF KIOWA ROAD AND TUSSING RANCH ROAD

Summary Statement:

On September 3, 2008, the Traffic Safety Committee met and evaluated the need for fourway STOP controls at the intersection of Kiowa Road and Tussing Ranch Road. The Committee concurred with the staff recommendation to establish the intersection as a fourway STOP. In addition, the Committee determined that rumble strips and flashers would be needed at this location. Attached is the staff report submitted to the Traffic Safety Committee for Council information.

Recommended Action:

Adopt Resolution 2008-54, "A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Apple Valley establishing the intersection of Kiowa Road and Tussing Ranch Road as a four-way STOP intersection."

Subject:	Four-way STOP sign installation at the intersection of Kiowa Road and Tussing
	Ranch Road

Staff received a request to investigate the intersection of Kiowa Road and Tussing Ranch Road to determine if a four-way stop is warranted. Currently there are STOP signs on the east and west legs of the intersection on Tussing Ranch Road.

Staff performed a traffic engineering investigation which included an evaluation of past records of vehicle conflict, traffic volumes, and a field review of the intersection. Four-way STOP controls may be warranted if 1) the total volume of the major approach legs of the intersection average 210 vehicles per hour for the peak eight hours and 2) that for the same eight hour period the minor approach legs average a total of 140 vehicles per hour. Currently the average is 373 vehicles per hour for the major legs and 87 vehicles per hour for the minor legs.

State warrants also indicate that if 5 accidents occur in a 12 month period that may be susceptible to correction by placing additional stop signs, a four way stop may be justified. Between February 2007 and February 2008 there have been six (6) traffic collisions at this intersection, and six (6) collisions occurred where additional stop signs may be a correction measure.

Staff investigated other factors including surrounding geography and intersection layout for clear sight views. There is a railroad crossing and a slight rise in the road on Tussing Ranch Road approximately 500 feet south of the intersection and a line of telephone poles on the east side of Tussing Ranch Road. Kiowa Road has 2 lanes of traffic in each direction with a speed limit of 50 mph. The east leg of Tussing Ranch Road has 2 lanes of traffic in each direction with a speed limit of 55 mph. The west leg of Tussing Ranch Road is dirt.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that four-way STOP controls be installed at the intersection of Kiowa Road and Tussing Ranch Road because the accident warrant has been met. However, because the southwest corner of the intersection is in the County, the Town will need to coordinate the final approval and installation with their department.





RESOLUTION NO. 2008-54

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF APPLE VALLEY ESTABLISHING THE INTERSECTION OF KIOWA ROAD AND TUSSING RANCH ROAD AS A FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTION.

WHEREAS, a traffic engineering investigation has determined that establishing the intersection of Kiowa Road and Tussing Ranch Road as a four-way STOP intersection is warranted in accordance with Section 52.0111 of the San Bernardino County Code as adopted by the Town of Apple Valley.

NOW THEREFORE, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF APPLE VALLEY DOES RESOLVE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approves and establishes the intersection of Kiowa Road and Tussing Ranch Road as a four-way STOP intersection.

Section 2: Authorizes and directs the Town Manager to cause additional STOP signs to be placed on Kiowa Road and Tussing Ranch Road.
