RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Award a contract to TSR Construction and Inspection for the Bear Valley Bus Stop Improvement Project subject to "Approval as to Form" by the Town Attorney and "Approval as to Content" by the Town Manager.

SUMMARY:

On October 30, 2018, the Town received and opened bids for the subject project in response to the Notice Inviting Sealed Bids issued by the Engineering Department on October 12, 2018. After reviewing the submissions, staff concluded that TSR Construction and Inspection is the lowest responsible, responsive bidder.

The results are as follows:

1. TSR Construction and Inspection	\$239,422.00
2. All American Asphalt	\$295,579.00
3. S&H Civil Works	\$298,821.00
4. Hardy & Harper	\$306,115.00
5. Roadway Engineering	\$338,400.00
6. Jergensen's Construction	\$392,292.25

BACKGROUND:

The project will construct a new VVTA standard bus turnout on Bear Valley Road between the easterly intersection of Outer Bear Valley Road and Snapping Turtle Road where a bus shelter currently exists. In addition, 10' wide sidewalk and ADA ramps will be constructed closing the gap between the existing sidewalk to the east of the bus shelter and to the west of Snapping Turtle.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this project has been appropriated in the Town Council approved 2018-2019 Capital Improvement Projects Budget using LTF funds.
