The center only accepts household hazardous waste

- ◆ No medical waste
- ◆ No explosives or radioactive waste
- ◆ No commercial or business waste

**Home-generated sharps such as needles and lancets in approved containers are accepted at the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center!**

## EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE WASTE INCLUDE:

- pesticides • wood preservatives • auto batteries • household batteries •
- paint • paint thinners • auto and furniture polish • herbicides •
- drain cleaners • antifreeze • fertilizers • poisons • household chemicals •
- small electronics • medical sharps • expired or unused medications •
- pool chemicals • expired medications • TV's • computer monitors •
- motor oil • oil filters • gasoline • hobby supplies • photographic

***Remember!* Drinking water comes from groundwater.**

**Never pour oil on the ground or in the trash.**

**Dispose of used motor oil ONLY at an oil collection center.**
