

Home-generated sharps such as needles and lancets in approved containers are now accepted at the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center!

The Town of Apple Valley offers free disposal of residential hazardous waste to San Bernardino County residents.

Open most Saturdays between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.

The center accepts only household waste.

No commercial or business waste is accepted.

No medical waste; except home-generated sharps.

No explosives or radioactive waste can be accepted.

Remember! Drinking water comes from groundwater.

Never pour oil on the ground or in the trash.

Dispose of used motor oil ONLY at an oil collection center.
