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### RECOMMENDED ACTION

- A. That the Town Council review and approve the bid documents for Apple Valley South Safe Routes to School Project – No. 2018-02.
- B. That the Town Council authorize staff to solicit bids for construction of said project.

### BACKGROUND

The Town of Apple Valley received an Active Transportation Program grant to design and construct improvements to enhance access to the Mariana Academy, the Sandia Academy, and Apple Valley High School. Improvements include street improvements as well as the addition of curb, gutter, sidewalks, ADA ramps, and high visibility crosswalks. In addition, the Class I bike path connecting Apple Valley High School to Tussing Ranch Road and from Navajo Road to Cochiti Road will be reconstructed. On March 27, 2018, The Town awarded a Professional Services Agreement to KOA Corporation to prepare the plans, specifications, and estimate for the project.

### ANALYSIS

Bid documents for the Apple Valley South Safe Routes to School Project have been prepared and are ready for approval and advertisement of bids. Staff has reviewed the documents and is satisfied that they meet the intent of the Town Council for this project. The documents are available to the Town Council for review, approval, and authorization to proceed with advertisement of the project. Staff recommends that the Town Council

review bid documents that are available in the Town Council Office, approve the documents, and direct staff to proceed with advertising for construction of the project.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

Funding for this project has been appropriated in the adopted FY 2019-2020 budget. There is no immediate impact for advertising this project.
