### RECOMMENDED ACTION

Award a contract to Christensen Brothers General Engineering for the Apple Valley South Safe Routes to School Project No. 2018-02 subject to “Approval as to Form” by the Town Attorney and “Approval as to Content” by the Town Manager.

### BACKGROUND

The Town of Apple Valley received an Active Transportation Program grant to design and construct improvements to enhance access to the Mariana Academy, the Sandia Academy, and Apple Valley High School. Improvements include street improvements as well as the addition of curb, gutter, sidewalks, ADA ramps, and high visibility crosswalks. In addition, the Class I bike path connecting Apple Valley High School to Tussing Ranch Road and from Navajo Road to Cochiti Road will be reconstructed. The plans and specifications were prepared by KOA Corporation.

On March 31, 2020, the Town received and opened bids for the subject project. The bid results are as follows:

## **ANALYSIS**

The bid documents for the project were reviewed by staff for accuracy and constructability. The bid documents and the authorization to advertise were approved by Town Council on February 25, 2020. Staff reviewed the bid submissions for completeness and considers Christensen Brothers General Engineering to be a qualified, responsible and responsive bidder.
