Contest Rules

Artwork Requirements-

<u>Photography</u>- Photos may not be graphically rendered in any way, but minor digital enhancements may be made such as cropping, fixing red-eye, or fill flash. Any type of camera and method of developing is acceptable. Only one image is allowed- no photo collages.

<u>Painting</u>- Paintings may be done on any surface and acceptable mediums are acrylic, oil, water color, tempera, gouache, ink (used with a paint brush), or any other water or oil based substance. *Paintings may be a maximum of 16" x 20"*

<u>Drawing</u>- Drawings may also be on any surface and acceptable mediums are pencil/graphite, colored pencil, charcoal, pastels, crayons, markers, chalk, gold foil (scratch art), pen/ink, or any other dry substance. *Drawings must be no larger than 14"x 20"*

<u>Digital Art</u>- digital art can be a photo that is modified with a computer program such as Photoshop or it can be an entirely computer-generated image (such as graphic images created through Illustrator). Artwork with multiple photo images must be your own photographs. You may not have an entire collage full of images pulled from the internet or magazines.

<u>Other Art</u>- At this time we are not accepting certain types of artwork, including, but not limited to: books of multiple drawings or paintings, scrapbook pages, magazine collages, textiles such as quilts or crocheted items, floral arrangements, table settings, and culinary art. All artwork should be your original work and have been produced after January 2020. Your artwork may not depict any of the following: racially or religiously offensive images, nudity, profanity, excessive violence or horror. Any artwork deemed offensive by preliminary judges will be disqualified. Any artwork that is found to not be solely produced by the artist submitting the work or was created more than a year ago will not be accepted.

<u>Artwork Submittal and Deadline:</u> All artwork is due by Sunday, May 17th, 7pm. All artwork must be accompanied by a completed registration form and be submit via the appropriate Dropbox link found on the Virtual Recreation page: <u>https://www.applevalley.org/services/parks-recreation/virtual-recreation</u> Each file must be labeled with the artist name and title of the artwork.
