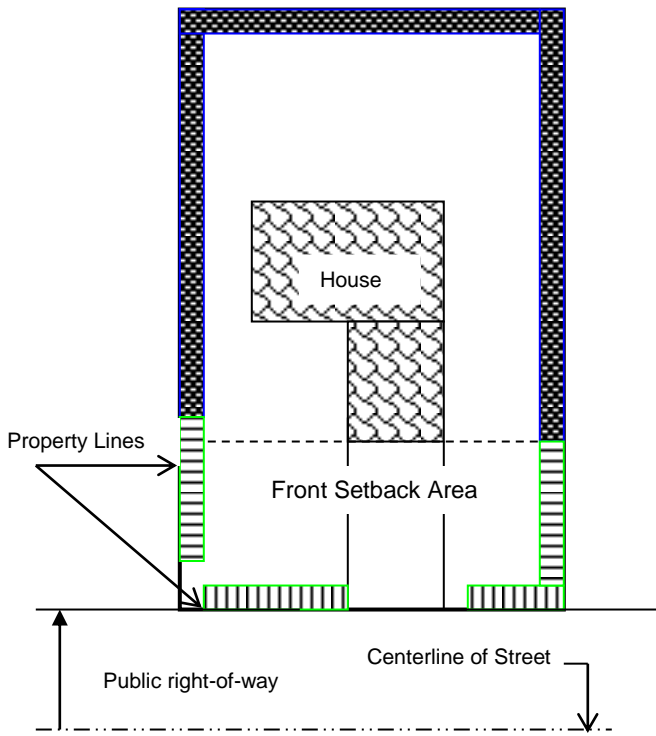


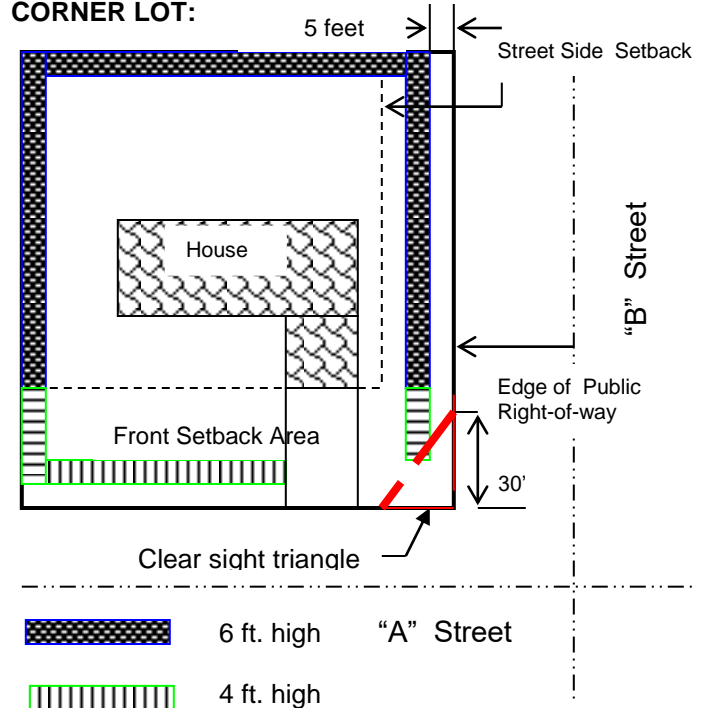
Fencing

Walls and fences in the front or street side yards along local streets equal to or exceeding the six (6)-foot height limit shall be set back a minimum of five (5) feet from the edge of the right-of-way to allow for landscaping. Where walls or fences cannot be avoided along the rear yard adjacent to a local street, a minimum setback of five (5) feet from the edge of the right-of-way shall be required to allow for landscaping. Wrought iron or other open fencing incorporating decorative features such as pilasters and spires or other embellishments, may obtain a height of six (6) feet within the front yard or street side yard setback. Chain link fencing is not permitted in front or street side setbacks on a property with a home constructed after June 7, 2007 in the R-EQ or R-SF zones.

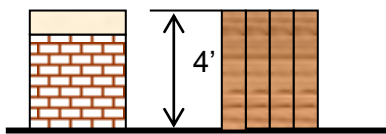


CORNER LOT:

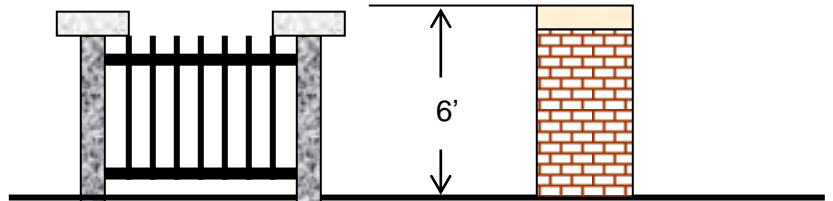


*Note: Edge of right away and property line are one in the same.

"A" Street



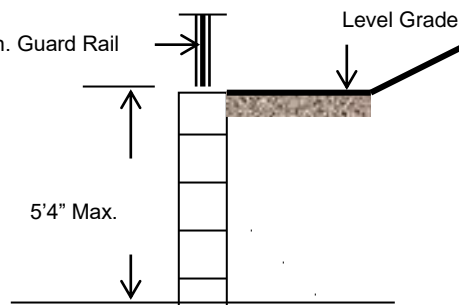
Solid Wall/Fence
