RECOMMENDED ACTION

That the Town Council:

- A. Accept the work completed as part of the Kasota-Tuscola Connector Road for a total contract cost of \$120.733.20.
- B. Direct the Town Clerk to file the Notice of Completion for the contract work.
- C. Direct the Finance Director to release the retained funds 30 days after the Notice of Completion has been filed, provided no claims are filed against the contractor.
- D. Accept Potomac Road from Kasota Road to Tuscola Road as a Town maintained road.

BACKGROUND

On October 17, 2018, the Planning Commission reviewed and approved permits for the demolition of the existing buildings and paved parking at the corner of Outer Highway 18 South and Kasota Road to allow for the construction of a new 4,574 square-foot commercial building, drive-thru lane, landscaping, and parking. As a condition of approval, the outer highway fronting the property will be eliminated between Tuscola Road and Kasota Road. The Town retained Merrell-Johnson to design a new access road 400' south of the project area which will allow for continuous east/west movement after the elimination of the outer highway. Due to its alignment with Potomac Road to the west, the new road segment has been named Potomac Road.

ANALYSIS

Engineering staff inspected the project area and deemed the work to be complete and acceptable.

FISCAL IMPACT


Funding for this project has been appropriated in the adopted FY 2019-2020 budget using Measure I funds allocated for FY 2020-2021. The timeline for construction of the project was accelerated due to the beginning of construction of the commercial project and elimination of the adjacent outer highway. On February 11, 2020, Council approved a Budget Amendment transferring funds from FY 2020-2021 to the current fiscal year.
