RECOMMENDED ACTION

The Town Manager and staff recommend the Town Council receive and file the following year end information from the Code Enforcement Department and potentially discuss for future use in determining priorities, human resource allocation and focal points for enforcement and solid waste efforts.

BACKGROUND

The Code Enforcement Department has experienced significant changes in the past two years. There have been changes in management, enforceable ordinances, fine structures and enforcement processes, as well as an increase in illegal dumping and illegal cannabis cultivation operations. Additionally, the Sheriff Department and Code Enforcement personnel have increased efforts to cleanup and abate illegal homeless encampments and is consistently conducting enforcement sweeps that are intended to address the Town's criminal transient population.

Over the last fiscal year, the Code Enforcement Department handled 3,004 proactive, reactive, and problem oriented enforcement cases and 2,675 rental property maintnenance inspections, for a combined total of 5,679 cases. The top fifteen violations were as follows.

ANALYSIS

The Town Manager, Assistant Town Manager, and Code Enforcement management staff formally meet monthly, and frequently in between, to discuss Code Enforcements current events and trends. During these discussions, the more complex cases and programs such as Rental Inspections, Neighborhood Cleanups and Household Hazardous Waste are also discussed and direction is given related to public information dissemination and future program growth.

In the report, but not in the top fifteen is "Prohibited Cannabis Operations" and "Camping Prohibited" with a total of 45 and 37 cases, respectively. These cases are typically more complex and require greater involvement by senior code enforcement personnel. "Prohibited Cannabis Operations" are mostly those cases wherein whole homes are converted to accommodate an illegal grow operation and "Camping Prohibited" cases typically involve criminal tranisents who have been offered and refused assistance from the Sheriff Department's Homeless Outreach Team. Code Enforcement often responds reactively to these complaints at the request of Sheriff Department peronnel and either issues notice and/or fines or removes trash and debris as deemed appropriate and within guidelines established by Code Enforcement Department policy.

Based on the aforementioned list of top fifteen violations, established and driven by complaints received by Code Enforcement, the priorities of our community are outstandingly apparent. Unless otherwise directed to do so, Code Enforcement will continue to focus its efforts on the top 4 and has recently hired four Maintenance Worker I's that will form an illegal dumping cleanup and violation abatement crew utilizing Solid Waste funds and grants from CalRecycle. The crew will focus on removing illegally dumped materials from vacant lots and the roadside aided by a recently acquired three quarter ton truck and fourteen foot hydraulic dump trailer.

FISCAL IMPACT
