PARKS & RECREATION MANAGER'S MESSAGE

Welcome Back! While technically most of us didn't leave, we did miss seeing you in all the familiar places. As the news these days seems to focus on the negative, let's take a moment to see what positive things have happened or are about to happen in Apple Valley while you've been away.

You might have noticed some improvements like upgraded sports turf as our Grounds Department worked hard to get our fields in tip top condition. Hitt Plumbing helped the Town and Apple Valley Little by moving and installing a backstop for baseball at James Woody Park just days before we hosted an Area 49 Little League Championship which our local boys won! Not sure if the improved backstop helped, but it didn't hurt!

Without the normal schedule of recreation programs to run, our full-time staff was able to focus on other items that benefitted from the increased attention. For example, we were presented with an unexpected grant opportunity that needed to be completed in just a few days. Not only did we get the applications in on time, we were successful and now the Town has new fitness equipment at three parks, James Woody, Thunderbird, and Brewster as well as one of the largest shade structures in the High Desert installed at Civic Center Park. Please visit all four! In addition, we turned in three highly detailed grants that, if successful, will add to our park system in areas not currently served. We needed your help in applying for these grants funded by the State Park Initiative known as Prop. 68, and many of you attended Community Input Zoom meetings. Your ideas were put to paper and we asked the state for over \$24 million for two new parks and a retrofit for James Woody Park. The vast majority of applications turned in are not rewarded, but it's nice to have a dream to which we can look forward. We call them our Dream Parks. We hope to know by the next our next publication date if Apple Valley was chosen, and trust me, you will hear about it if we get one!

Speaking of being chosen, the entire Country got to see a quick glimpse of how beautiful Apple Valley is as our own Chayce Beckham was voted the next American Idol as he played a clandestine sunset concert at Horsemen's Center Park, fostering even more dreaming.

So while we are in, what we hope, is the closing chapter of this horrendous COVID book, we have these dreams and many more for in store for the residents of Apple Valley. Stay positive!
