3. CDBG/GRANTS UPDATE

Parks & Recreation Secretary, Debbie Rivera, advised the Commission of the following projects:

- Mendel Restroom Broke Ground on Monday, October 18th, completion planned for end of year.
- Camera Project moving forward. The cameras have been selected and the procurement process has been started. Chair Wilson asked if we need to go out to bid again and Debbie advised that if the installation is handled in-house there is no need to re-bid.
- Yucca Loma park is first to receive a new playground. Planning for rest of parks, both units and timeline.

PROP 68 Grants

Debbie advised the Commission that No news is good news. We have not received any information regarding the awards for the grants. OGALS will call if we receive a grant, or email if we don't. We will notify the commission if we receive notification prior to the December 2, 2021 meeting.

Commissioner Tatera requested an update on Horsemens Center Well. Debbie advised that Parks and Recreation Manager, David Coleman will provide an update.

4. POLICIES & PROCEDURES MANUAL/MUNICIPAL CODE REVIEW

Parks & Recreation Secretary, Debbie Rivera advised the commission that we are looking for input and recommendations on improvements and changes to outdated policies for the department. She advised the commission to call or email any changes that they would like to see regarding the policies and procedures. She also advised

that the Parks & Recreation staff are currently working on updating the policies and procedures and the Municipal Code.

Debbie provided the commissioners with an example of the outdated policies and codes. Commissioner Tatera advised that he had not received a copy of the policies or codes in the past.

Ex// Skate park doesn't allow scooters, but the department wants to allow them.

The Commissioners advised Debbie that they will review the documents and notify staff of any recommendations.

5. APPLE VALLEY GOLF COURSE UPDATE

Parks & Recreation Secretary, Debbie Rivera, advised the commission that the contract management has been taken over by Parks & Recreation department. Sierra Golf Management still holds contract. Parks & Recreation are doing research into operation and business practices, seeking efficiency. Please direct all questions to David Coleman or the Recreation Department directly.

Commissioner Tatera advised the Commission of the Ribbon Cutting at the Civic Center Park Shade Pavilion. He advised that it was a good event followed by the Howl-oween Dog Walk. He advised that there was a good turnout at the event, and it was fun watching all the dogs dressed up as well.




