



APPLE VALLEY PARKS AND RECREATION MANAGER'S MESSAGE

We Are Better Together

In a recent poll performed by the National Recreation and Park Association, 83% of adults said that exercising at local parks, trails and open spaces is essential to maintaining their mental and physical health. Popular activities included walking, jogging, hiking, and biking. Parks make you better.

But our parks need you. Parks are better when you are in them. Families in parks make them safer. Your presence improves our parks. You see things. You have ideas.

If you've spent time recently in any of Apple Valley's parks, you might have noticed some of the improvements that we've added. Many of the improvements came directly from your comments. For example, we were conducting the Prop. 68 mandated polling outreach and a large percentage responded that increasing shade in parks was important. When the state offered COVID infrastructure dollars we were able to secure them and build a bigger and better shade pavilion at Civic Center Park without drawing on the general fund. Adding even more shade, we have a grant that will allow us to add over 100 trees in a park this spring. In similar fashion, we installed fitness equipment in three of our parks based on your comments. We leveraged state funding to add




air conditioning to the Michael H. Martin gym, and we will see a brand-new restroom at Mendel Park open very soon, paid by Community Development Block Grant (CDGB) funds. We are being very resourceful and opportunistic to add amenities while not taxing the general fund.

Some projects that we all want, like sufficient water at Horsemen's Park, more sports fields, snack bars and restrooms, have obstacles that need to be addressed before we can complete. We are striving to do what we can do as quickly as resources and logistics line up.

Speaking of Proposition 68, the largest state grant for parks ever, we have not yet heard about our applications for adding recreation opportunities in Apple Valley. If one or more of Apple Valley's projects are selected, we will present plans to eliminate added cost to the general fund, like partnerships and use fees that will cover the ongoing cost of maintenance. Any of our three projects would be great news for increasing the health and well being of Apple Valley Residents. JR. LIFEGUARD TRAINING

Course is designed to guide youth by building a foundation of knowledge, attitudes and skills for future lifeguards. Junior Lifeguarding is an effective transition from upper level learn-to-swim courses to the lifeguard program, challenging participants to stay involved with aquatics. This course also provides the Town with a known group from which to recruit future lifeguards. Participants will learn: skills needed for entry to the Lifeguard course, communication & decision-making skills, basic responsibilities, knowledge & the skills to become a lifeguard. 30 hours of volunteer time is required for completion.


RELEASE OF LIABILITY
