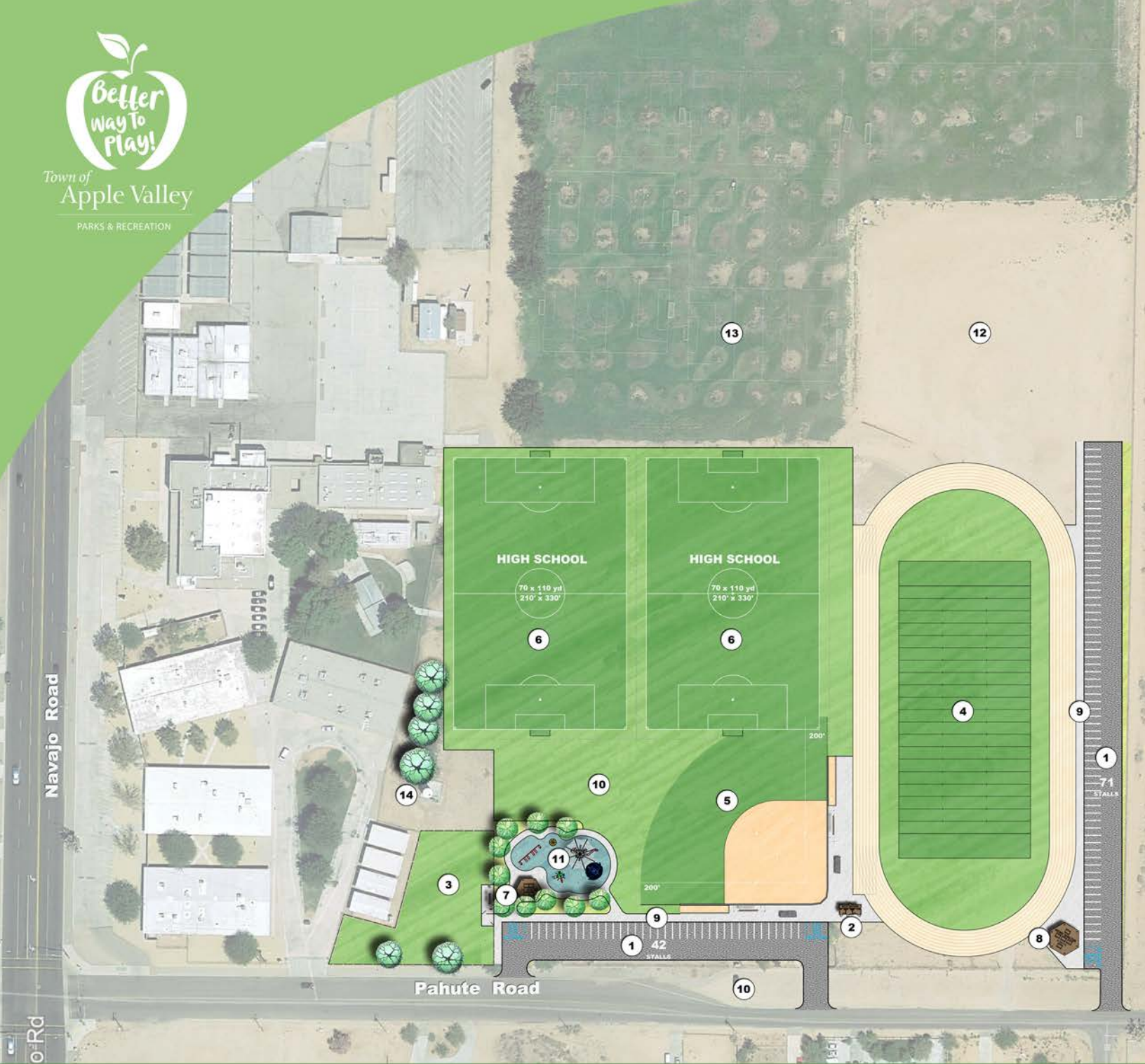

APPLE VALLEY PARKS AND RECREATION MANAGER'S MESSAGE

We Got It!

If you remember when we last spoke, we were waiting to hear from the State Parks Office of Grants and Local Services to see if our applications were chosen to receive funding of up to \$8.5 million to build a new park. We've heard and they loved one of our entries of building a brand new park on the property behind the Apple Valley Unified School District (AVUSD) offices at Navajo and Pahute! They awarded us the full amount of \$8,494,127 as requested.

Pahute Park, which was designed with community input, will feature a little bit of a lot! Two soccer fields, a youth baseball field, a football field, a synthetic running track, dog park, a playground and more!

AVUSD and the Town agreed to a 30-year lease on the property that will be home to a park that will truly offer something for everyone. From birthday parties and high school track meets to festivals and tournaments, the park will be a popular choice for families, schools, youth sports leagues and just about anyone looking for healthy activities.

We have just three years to complete this project and we're planning on having it open to the public by December 2024! We are committed and required to offer the main amenities that were presented, but if there is extra money after completing our plan, we can add amenities. The state would rather have us spend every dollar on the park and not return anything. So like before, when we held multiple Zoom meetings and had the Rec Van at our parks to collect public ideas and preferences, we will be out and asking what you want in your park.

The next step is to hire a landscape architecture firm through a Request For Proposal (RFP) process to provide complete plans and then work with a contractor to actually build it as planned.

As you look at the concept plan on the opposite page, know that we will be contacting and working with local sports groups and other enthusiasts groups as well as our local high school athletic directors and coaching staff. This is a once in a lifetime opportunity for Apple Valley!

We should have some more exciting news to share when our Fall Edition hits your mailbox in August.

Level Tad: Tadpoles - Parent and Child Level 1 - Objectives: Introduce children to swimming and water safety and lay foundation for future learning. Parents are taught how to properly support and guard their children in an aquatic environment.

Lessons for Children 5 and up

To determine the best level to your child, read the "Exit Skills" listed for each level. If your child can do the exit skills listed, proceed to the next level. Once you reach a level that your child can no longer perform the exit skills, you have found their appropriate swim lesson level! If your child can perform the exit skills listed for each level, but still needs more instruction, we recommend Private Swim Lessons or the Apple Valley Swim Club.

Level 1: Introduction to Water Skills - Objectives: Learn Personal water safety skills, feel comfortable in the water and enjoy water safely.
Ages 5 & up

Exit Skills:

1. Enter the water independently, using either the ladder, steps or side. Swim at least 5 yards, bob 3 times, then safely exit the water.
2. Glide on front at least 2 body lengths, roll to a back float for 3 seconds & recover to a vertical position

Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills - Objectives: Further develop arm and leg action, lay foundation for future strokes
Ages 5 & up

Exit Skills:

1. Steps from side into chest-deep water, move into a front float for 5 second, roll to back float for 45 seconds, return to vertical.
2. Push off and swim using combined arm and leg action on front for 5 body lengths, roll to back float for 15 seconds, roll to front and continue swimming for 5 body lengths.

Level 3: Stroke Improvement - Objectives: Improve skills and increase endurance. Learn Sidestroke, breaststroke and explore Butterfly Stroke.
Ages 6 & up

Exit Skills:

1. Jump into deep water from side, swim Front crawl 25 yards, perform open turn, swim Elementary Backstroke 25 yards.
2. Perform Breaststroke for 15 yards, perform open turn, swim Back Crawl for 15 yards.

Level 4: Stroke Improvement - Objectives: Improve Skills and Increase endurance. Learn Sidestroke, Breaststroke and explore Butterfly Stroke.
Ages 6 & up

Exit Skills:

1. Perform feet-first entry into deep water, swim Front Crawl 25 yards, perform open turn, swim Elementary Backstroke 25 yards.
2. Perform Breaststroke for 15 yards, perform open turn, swim Back Crawl for 15 yards.

Level 5: Stroke Refinement- Objective: Refine performance of all strokes. increase distances. introduce flip turns.
Ages 6 & up

Exit Skills

1. Perform a shallow-angle dive, swim Front Crawl for 50 yards, performing flip turns as necessary, swim Elementary Backstroke for 50 yards.
2. Swim Breaststroke for 25 yards, perform flip turns as necessary, swim Back Crawl for 25 yards.

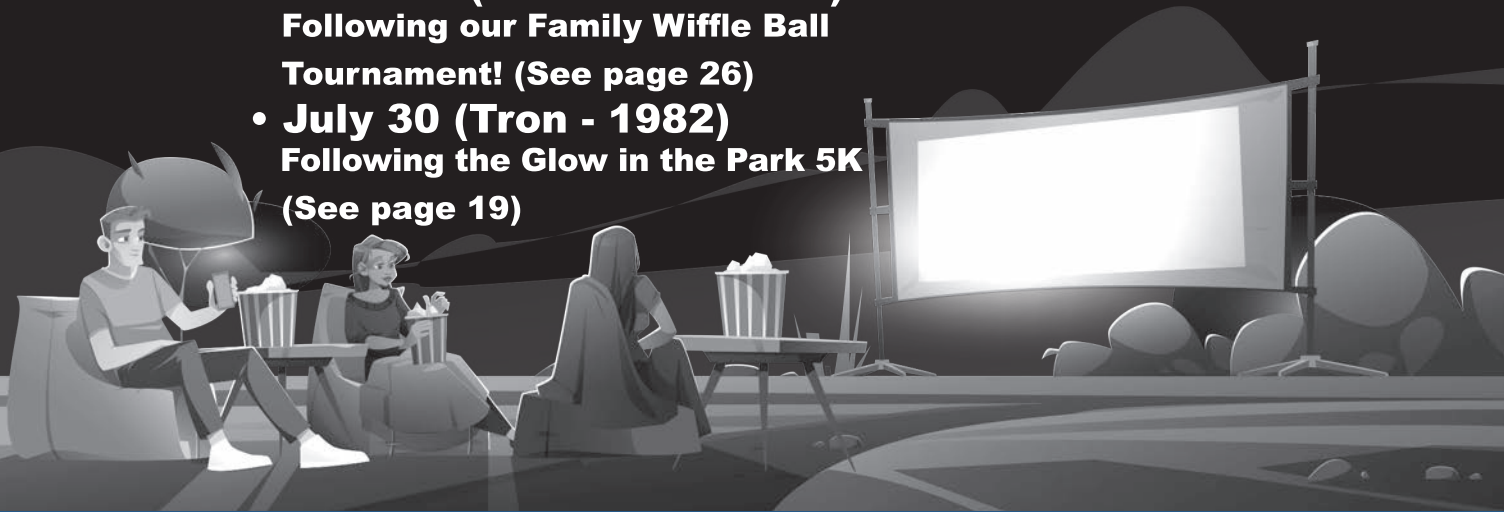

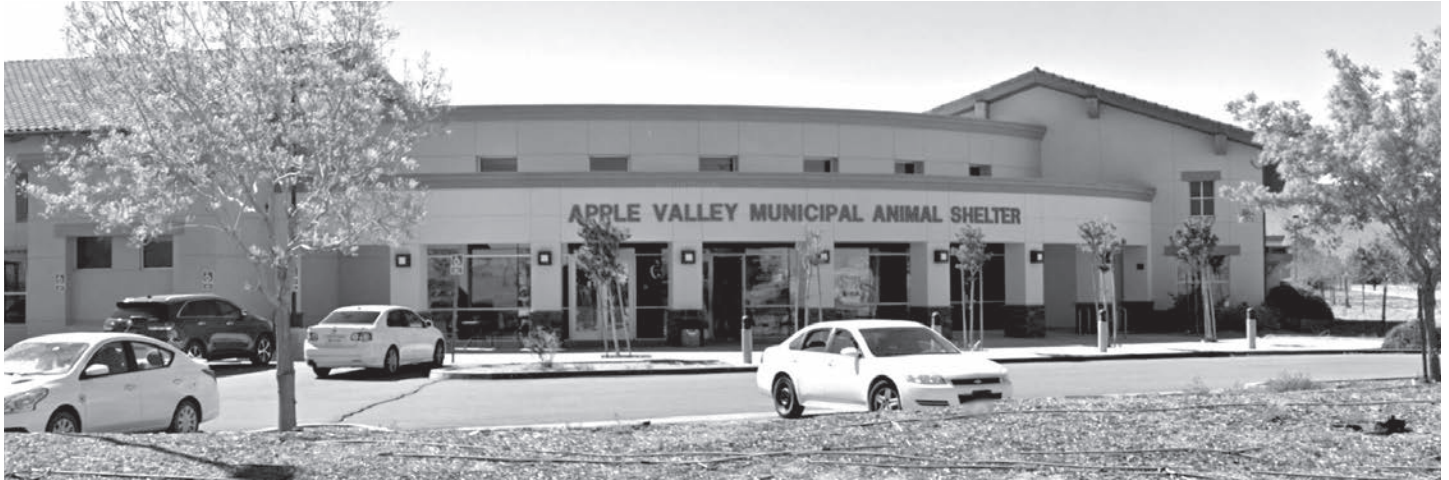

REFUND POLICY

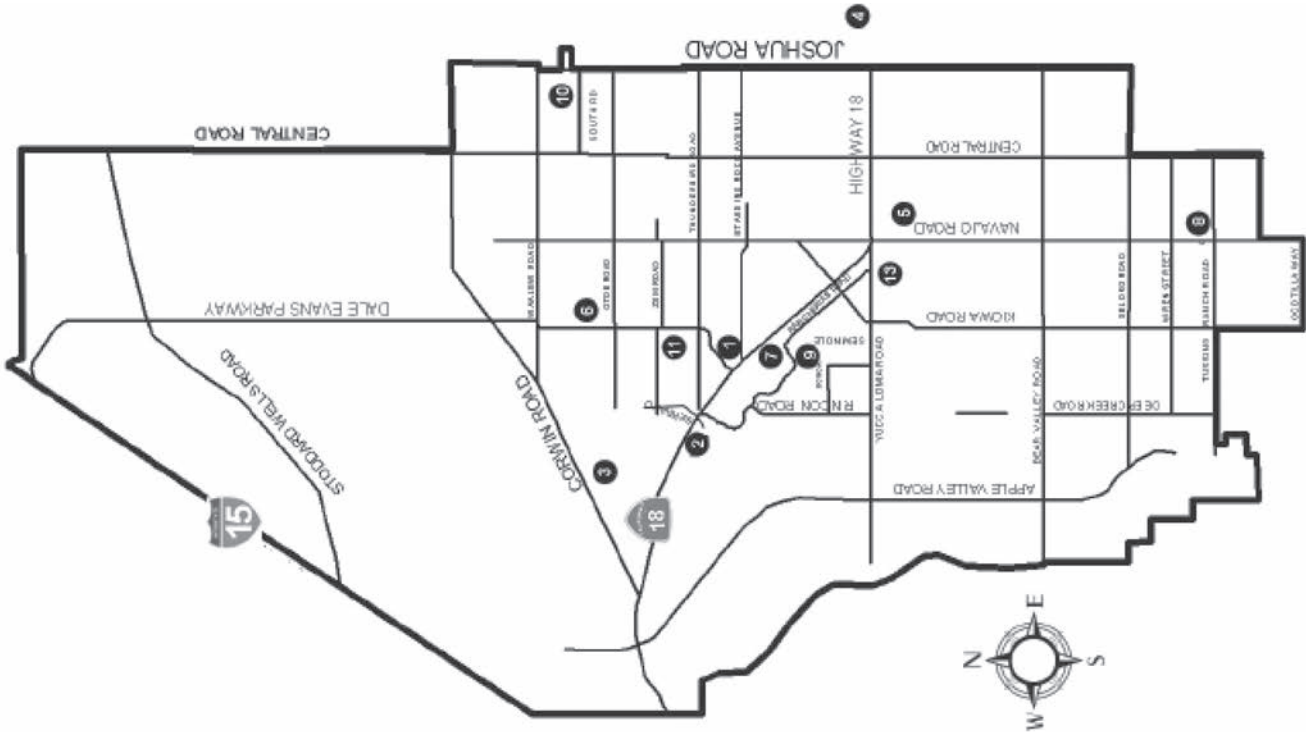
