Junior Lifeguarding is an effective transition from upper level learn-to-swim courses to the lifeguard program, challenging participants to stay involved with aquatics. This course also provides the Town with a known group from which to recruit future lifeguards. Participants will learn: skills needed for entry to the Lifeguard course, communication & decision-making skills, basic responsibilities, knowledge & the skills to become a lifeguard. 30 hours of volunteer time is required for completion.
