The Community Enhancement Crew consists of four full-time Community Enhancement staff members.

The Community Enhancement Crew proactively patrols and removes illegal dumps from the community.

They also assist with community enhancement events, Public Works, household hazardous waste and other functions throughout the town. The crew works Monday through Saturday.

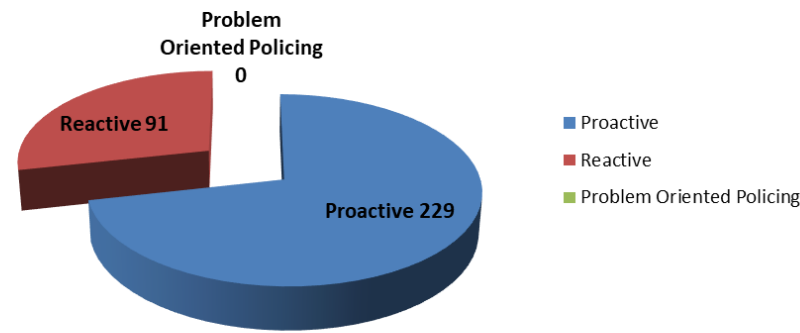

Code Enforcement Spotlight

On September 8, 2021, Code Enforcement responded to an apartment complex in the 16100 block of Kamana on a complaint of trash and debris. When Officers arrived, they observed discarded furniture, household trash, overgrown vegetation, and a swimming pool gate in need of repair. Notices and citations were sent to the property owner. On February 16, 2022, a follow up inspection was conducted, and all violations had been corrected.
