The Community Enhancement Crew consists of four full-time Community Enhancement staff members.

The Community Enhancement Crew proactively patrols and removes illegal dumps from the community.

They also assist with Community Enhancement events, Public Works, Household Hazardous Waste and other functions throughout the Town. The crew works Monday through Saturday.

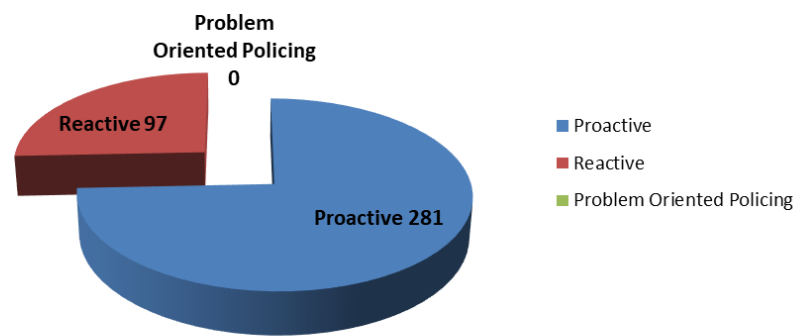
On Saturday, May 14, 2022, between the hours of 8:00am and 2:00pm, Community Enhancement staff hosted a Neighborhood Cleanup at Lion's Park. 285 citizens participated in the event bringing a total of 74 tons of trash and debris, 8 tons of recyclables, and 2 tons of green waste. 14 front loader trash trucks from Burrtec were used to collect the trash and debris along with 4 bins for recyclables and 3 rear loaders for green waste.

Code Enforcement Spotlight

On March 24, 2022, a Code Enforcement Officer observed excessive trash and debris and an inoperative vehicle in the front yard in the 21000 block of Thunderbird Road. A Notice of Violation was sent to the property owner. After working with the property owner, a follow up inspection was conducted on May 18, 2022, and all the violations were abated.



Did you know?

AVMC 6.40.030(B)(1) Water Drainage.

(B) All water users in the Town of Apple Valley shall abide by the following water conservation measures: (1) The use of water for any purpose shall not result in flooding or runoff in gutters, driveways, streets or adjacent lands.
