29,828 pounds of trash and debris was collected in May




















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On Saturday, May 14, 2022, between the hours of 8:00am and 2:00pm, Community Enhancement staff hosted a Neighborhood Cleanup at Lion's Park. 285 citizens participated in the event bringing a total of 74 tons of trash and debris, 8 tons of recyclables, and 2 tons of green waste.

14 front loader trash trucks from Burrtec were used to collect the trash and debris along with 4 bins for recyclables and 3 rear loaders for green waste.


