Summer Concert booth was approved; new buildings in town; finish driving tour; preserve history of Apple Valley; and convert historical books into videos.

5.3 **Driving tour next steps to honor Committee Member Risk Piercy**  
Chair Orr stated the tour may not be used in its current state. Vice Chair Taylor stated she would drive it and provide feedback to the committee.

Special Projects Manager Ryan read letter from family making the request. Vice Chair Taylor provided the history of the family and suggested that Ken and Edna Hollenbeck be used when a new street name is needed in Town.  
**Motion by Chair Orr:** Request Council to direct Planning to name a street after the Hollenbeck when a new street name is needed.  
**Seconded by:** Committee Member Davisson  
Motion passed 4/0 with Committee Member Hoegerman absent.
