## Maintenance Worker I

### The Position

Under direct supervision, learns to and performs a variety of work in the construction, modification, maintenance, repair, and operation of Town infrastructure, including landscapes and the care and maintenance of the Town's municipal golf course, abatement of violations and cleanup of illegal dumping sites; and performs related work as required.

## Job Functions

- Performs a variety of technical landscape maintenance and care of golf course greens, fairway and trees including mowing, top dressing, planting, transplanting, cultivating, watering, and trimming.
- Repairs ball marks on greens, tees, and fairway divots.
- Maintains bunkers and sand traps, changes holes and performs other general maintenance on walkways, roadways, and buildings on the golf course.
- Perform required maintenance on power equipment.
- Perform all job duties with particular attention to good public relations, safety, health, and proper procedures.
- Report maintenance needs to the supervisor on a timely basis.
- Observes safe work methods and makes appropriate use of related safety equipment as required.
- Operates and maintains light, medium, and heavy-duty equipment and trucks appropriate to the functional area of assignment.
- Operates a variety of hand and power tools and equipment related to work assignment as instructed.
- Maintains work areas in a clean and orderly condition, including securing equipment at the close of the workday.
- Orders supplies and materials as needed and as directed.
- Installs street barricades and cones and controls traffic around work sites to ensure safe conditions for the general public and Town workers.
- Responds to after-hours emergencies.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

## Qualifications

Any combination of training and experience which would provide the required knowledge, skills, and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the required qualifications would be:

Equivalent to the completion of the twelfth (12<sup>th</sup>) grade and one (1) year of experience in construction, maintenance, or repair of parks and landscapes. Experience in irrigation technology is highly desired.
