AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE CORWIN ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT 2009-04: HIGHWAY 18 TO RAMONA ROAD (APPLE VALLEY AIRPORT)

Summary Statement:

On July 30, 2008, the Town received and opened bids for the subject contract. This project includes providing necessary labor, equipment and materials for the reconstruction and widening of Corwin Road, from Highway 18 to Ramona Road (Apple Valley Airport), as well as the reconstruction of Waalew Road, from Corwin Road to Ramona Road.

The bid results are as follows:

Sully-Miller Contracting Co.	\$3,052,980.00
Cooley Construction Inc.	\$3,138,067.30
Skanska Inc.	\$3,860,000.00
Vance Corporation	\$4,074,704.00

Staff is satisfied that Sully-Miller Contracting Co. is a responsible contractor for this work. The winning bid for this project came in approximately \$450,000 less than the engineer's estimate for this project. However, funding for this project was only partially appropriated in the Town's Capital Improvement Project budget for this fiscal year, with \$1,400,000 in Measure I funds and \$1,000,000 in Prop 1b funds. If approved as recommended, including a 10% contingency, an additional \$960,000 will need to be allocated from the Town's Transportation Impact Fee fund.

Recommended Action:

Direct the Finance Division to allocate \$960,000 from the Transportation Impact Fee fund and award a contract to Sully-Miller Contracting Co., for the Corwin Road Improvement Project, subject to "Approval as to Form" by the Town Attorney and "Approval as to Content" by the Town Manager.
