FEE WAIVER REQUEST FOR THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY 2010 RELAY FOR LIFE.

Summary Statement:

On 8-14-01, the Town Council adopted a policy stating fees can be administratively waived for a local public agency, a utility company or service district, or a similar entity providing an essential service to the general community, whereas, non-profit requests for fee waivers must go before the Town Council for consideration.

The American Cancer Society (ACS) Relay for Life is requesting a waiver of park rental fees for the event on May 22-23, 2010. This will be the 8th annual Apple Valley Relay, and the third year at Civic Center Park. An employee team raises money and participates in the walk annually while Council comes to the opening ceremonies. We've issued proclamations each year. This year, Levi James, Shelter Attendant, is serving as Chair of the event.

The fees come to \$2982.40. It is an overnight event, so it's based on amphitheater rental for 36.5 hours. ACS is completing all appropriate paperwork, including the Facility Use Agreement and Certificate of Liability.

Support of events such as this also fits in with the recent Council adoption of the Healthy Community resolution.

Recommended Action:

For good cause shown, and finding a waiver will serve a public purpose, approve the waiver of the Facility Rental Fee of \$2982.40.
