**FEE WAIVER REQUEST FOR THE SALVATION ARMY THANKSGIVING DAY DINNER NOVEMBER 25, 2010 AT THE JAMES WOODY COMMUNITY CENTER.**

**Summary Statement:**

On 8-14-01, the Town Council adopted a policy stating fees can be administratively waived for a local public agency, a utility company or service district, or a similar entity providing an essential service to the general community, whereas, non-profit requests for fee waivers must go before the Town Council for consideration.

The Salvation Army of Victor Valley is requesting use of the Auditorium at the James Woody Community Center on November 25, 2010 in order to provide a free Thanksgiving meal for those in the community. They will be working closely with the Apple Valley Kiwanis Club and community volunteers in order to put on this event. They anticipate serving 150 – 200 meals to people who would otherwise have no where else to go for Thanksgiving dinner.

The fees come to \$110.80. The organization will still be required to provide a Certificate of Insurance.

**Recommended Action:**

For good cause shown, and finding a waiver will serve a public purpose, approve the waiver of the Facility Rental Fee of \$110.80.
