**FEE WAIVER REQUEST FOR THE PHOENIX FOUNDATION CANDLELIGHT VIGIL JULY 9, 2010 AT THE CIVIC CENTER AMPHITHEATER.**

**Summary Statement:**

On 8-14-01, the Town Council adopted a policy stating fees can be administratively waived for a local public agency, a utility company or service district, or a similar entity providing an essential service to the general community, whereas, non-profit requests for fee waivers must go before the Town Council for consideration.

The Phoenix Foundation is a group of citizens in the high desert with the intention of helping families who have had a tragedy in their lives. They would like to host a candlelight vigil on July 9, 2010 at the Civic Center Amphitheater recognizing families who have lost a child. They have submitted a written request to have the rental fees waived by the Town.

The fees come to \$279.60. The organization will still be required to provide a Certificate of Insurance.

**Recommended Action:**

For good cause shown, and finding a waiver will serve a public purpose, approve the waiver of the Facility Rental Fee of \$279.60.
