Subject Item:

REQUEST TO VACATE A PORTION OF OUTER HIGHWAY 18 NORTH ADJACENT TO THE SAINT MARY MEDICAL CENTER

Summary Statement:

Staff received a request from the St. Mary Medical Center to vacate a portion of Outer Highway 18 North, at the northeast corner of Outer Highway 18 and Kasota Road. The subject easement is located along the southerly portion of the lot as shown on the Exhibit "B" attached to the Resolution.

The Applicant requests that the northerly 16 feet of the existing 45 feet wide Town's right-of-way for the Outer Highway 18 North be vacated to give the Hospital additional land for potential expansion of their facilities. The Town would retain the remaining 29 feet wide portion for potential future widening of State Route 18 to 3 westbound lanes, sidewalks, turning lanes and any other street related uses.

Recommended Action:

- Find that a 16-foot wide portion of the street easement of Outer Highway 18 North, located adjacent to the Saint Mary Medical Center, is in excess of need right-ofway and not required for street purposes; and the proposed vacation is exempt from CEQA;
- Adopt Resolution No. 2008-05, A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Apple Valley, California, vacating a portion of street easement at the St. Mary Medical Center, pursuant to the Streets and Highway Code Section 8333-8334.5";
- Instruct the Town Clerk to cause the Resolution vacating a portion of the street easement to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of the County of San Bernardino pursuant to Section 8336 of the Streets and Highways Code.

A portion of the street easement may be summarily vacated under the provisions of Section 8334(a) of the Streets and Highway Code because the following conditions apply to this request:

"(a) An excess right-of-way of a street or highway not required for street or highway purposes."

Because Outer Highway 18 North has been removed as a result of the "Highway 18/ Corwin Road Signal Project" there is no current or prospective use of this 16-foot wide section of street easement. No posting, advertising or public hearing is necessary.


Once the Council adopts the resolution vacating the easement, the Town Clerk will record the resolution of vacation. After the resolution is recorded, the vacation is complete.

RESOLUTION No. 2008-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF APPLE VALLEY, CALIFORNIA, VACATING A PORTION OF THE STREET EASEMENT AT THE SAINT MARY MEDICAL CENTER, PURSUANT TO THE STREETS AND HIGHWAY CODE SECTION 8333-8334.5

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF APPLE VALLEY, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> the Town Council of the Town of Apple Valley, California, intends to vacate a 16-foot wide portion of a street easement lying adjacent to the south boundary of the Parcel described in Exhibit "C", as per grant dead, document number 91-357811, recorded in Official Records, San Bernardino County, State of California; and

Section 2: the Town Council of the Town of Apple Valley now finds that it is now in the public interest that a portion of said easement be vacated, and the easement for Outer Highway 18 South is in excess of needed right-of-way and not required for street purposes, it hereby meets the requirements of section 8334(a), of the Streets and Highways Code;

<u>Section 3</u>: That pursuant to the Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law, Division 9, Part 3 Chapter 4, (Summary Vacation), California Streets and Highways Code beginning at section 8300, relating to the vacation of public streets, highways, and service easements, the following described easement for street purposes is hereby vacated:

For legal description see the Exhibits "A" and "B" both attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

Affects Assessor's Parcels: 473-101-39

<u>Section 4</u>: The Town Clerk shall record this Resolution of vacation pursuant to Streets and Highways Code section 8336.

<u>Section 5</u>: That from and after the date this Resolution is recorded, said portion of the highway easement shall no longer constitute an easement over that portion hereinabove described.

Section 6: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the Town shall be deemed to have adopted this resolution without such section.


